In its May 2006 edition, **test** magazine states that highest quality and the use of natural raw materials are perfectly combined in the test winning product from AURO. The 22 tested products included all kinds of woodstains from modern water-based products to conventional solvent products to high solid stains.

The AURO Woodstain No. 160 emerged from this test as the overall test winning product and left all competitors behind, the ones from the conventional paint industry as well as other natural paint products that were tested.
